Beefbar on the Beach

St Paul's Bay, Malta

Humbert & Poyet has crafted a locally-inspired interior for Beefbar's latest opening in Malta's St Paul's Bay.

Humbert & Poyet has created celebrated designs for Beefbar's outlets across the globe, from Paris to Hong Kong. For the restaurant brand's latest opening, its first beach club concept, the Monaco-based design duo drew inspiration from Malta's seascape, natural stone and local craftsmen to deliver a memorable dining experience.

A central component of Humbert & Poyet's brief was to accentuate the restaurant's vast, open-plan layout. A warm colour palette, awash with soft earthy tones, maintains an airy, organic feel, while pops of bright canary yellow, tangerine orange, emerald green and touches of black enliven the space.

This uplifting ambience is echoed in the use of natural and raw materials, including rattan, ceramic, plaster and concrete, alongside playfully-patterned furniture pieces in fine textured fabrics. Lush decorative greenery adorns the entrance, lounge, restaurant, terrace and pool.

Malta's picturesque sea-line, with its cascading rocks, acts as a key focal point for both the interior and exterior spaces. Outside, a smart terrace area blends elegant rattan, banquette and upholstered seating for a picture-perfect setting.

Separated from the terrace only by a soft, textural line of grasses, the pool area features a smattering of elegant pergolas which artfully frame the cerulean Mediterranean sea.
